Day One (22/02/2022)

On Tuesday, February 22, 2022, at 9:00 am, volunteers and program coordinators from college left for the Holkar Wada campsite for the inauguration of the venue. The students had decorated the entire campus for the opening ceremony. After completing all the preparations of the program, the inaugural ceremony began at approximately 4:00 pm. Prominent attendees included Dr. Indrajeet Jadhav, Principal, B.D. Kale Mahavidyalaya, Ghodegav and the president of the program was Dr. Pandurang Gaikwad, the principal of Mahatma Phule Mahavidyalaya. On that day, all the students were divided into different groups,

and formed a total of seven groups by including different students. Each group was assigned daily tasks, and the camp began after the allocation of tasks.

Day Two (23/02/2022)

On Wednesday morning, from 6 am to 9 am, all volunteers performed various types of exercises and Yoga, and the day started. Later, from 9 am to 12 noon, all volunteers took part in a cleanliness campaign at the Holkar (Fort) Wada premises. They cleaned the entire area, including the banks of the nearby river where they removed weeds. The fort premises were completely cleaned. A large group of volunteers came to clean the well. The trees in the courtyard of Yashwantrao Holkar School were pruned in an organized manner. The trees were pruned in the appropriate way and given the right shape. After lunch at 3:30 pm, the Principal of the ITI, Khed, Jagdish Jagtap guided to the students on "Opportunities for Employment". He discussed the new opportunities for employment available today in detail, and also engaged in dialogue with the students. The program received an excellent response from all the volunteers. In the evening, a cultural program and sports activities were held.

Day Three (24/02/2022)

On Thursday morning, from 6 to 8 am, the daily assembly was conducted for the students. Each group presented their activities and achievements in various locations and organizations. These included initiatives such as cleanliness drive in the village panchayat and primary school in the area, as well as a major cleaning effort in the main temple and surrounding areas. In the afternoon, after lunch at 3:30, Mr. Jayakant Shikre, a castle researcher and scholar, presented a lecture titled "Forts and Castles: Eyewitness of the history" in which he shared his comprehensive knowledge of the castle and its surroundings with the students. Dr. Madhav Sarode presided over the program. Students organized cultural and recreational activities in the evening. The program received an excellent response from all volunteers.

Day Four (25/02/2022)

On Friday morning, from 6 to 8 am, after the morning assembly, some groups were sent to clean up other places in the village. Jayakant Shikre spoke to the students about the importance of the village's history and the main entrance door of the village. A group of students from a village conducted a cleanliness drive and after having lunch at 3:30 pm, they attended a lecture on "Ancient Indian Weapons and its Demonstrations" by Mr. Ravindra Jagdale, a weapons expert. He provided information on the subject and demonstrated the use of weapons, and his

daughter also demonstrated how to handle weapons. After the lecture, a weapons and handicraft exhibition was organized, in which the students of Yashwantrao Holkar School also participated. As part of the program, the students prepared posters on various topics related to society and presented them. The exhibition showcased these posters.

Day Five (26/02/2022)

On Saturday morning, from 6 to 8 am, the volunteers conducted yoga exercises and recited daily poems. Afterward, each group of volunteers was assigned to survey a designated section of the Vafgaon village in regards to its economic and social conditions. Each volunteer was given a form to conduct the survey. The survey was conducted successfully by all volunteers, and they were able to gather comprehensive information on the economic and social conditions of the village. Overall, the program was a great success after lunch at 3:30 pm, Dr. Neelkanth Dahale, IQAC Coordinator, delivered a lecture on the topic "Social Consciousness in Youth" and provided guidance to the students on the same. The program was chaired by Dr. Kamayani Survey, Head of the Hindi Department. She guided the students on how they should be sensitive to social issues.

Day Six (27/02/2022)

In the morning from 6 to 8, yoga exercises and recitation of poems were conducted by volunteers. After that, a village clean-up drive was organized by the students. The surroundings of the Rayreshwar temple in the village were cleaned up, and awareness was raised among the people through unique social programs and informative campaigns. In the afternoon, through theatrical performances, social awareness and knowledge were imparted to the students, and a group discussion on the "National Service Scheme and Me" was conducted.

Day Seven (28/02/2022)

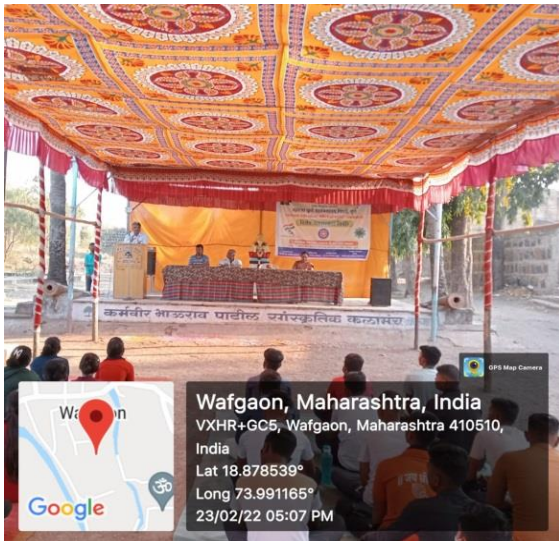
