T.Y.B.Sc. and M.Sc. II students participated in Avishkar Competition conducted by SPPU.

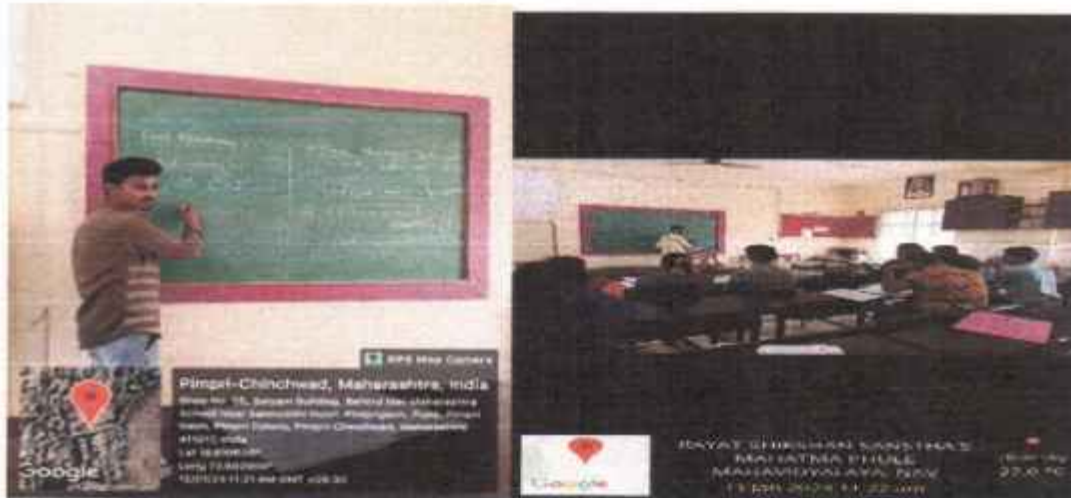





Report

Department of Chemistry organized a study tour to IISER Pune on 18th January 2023 for U.G. and P.G. students. 38 students participated for this visit with 3 faculties. The study tour started from Science Activity Centre of IISER, Pune. The faculties of IISER gave power point presentation regarding information about IISER Pune, like establishment year, current programs offered and their extension activities. Afterwards they showed various experiments in science explaining various concepts in science used in daily life in order to inculcate research attitude amongst students. They showed experiments related to dispersion of light beam, rubbing of coins with balloon edges, proper and improper paper cutting, wave formation, oscillation of magnet and coil, etc. Then during lunch break students interacted with IISER faculties on various subjects. After lunch IISER faculties showed all the campus including chemistry, physics, mathematics and biology laboratories and various instrumentation labs & library. Visit ended with a photosession.

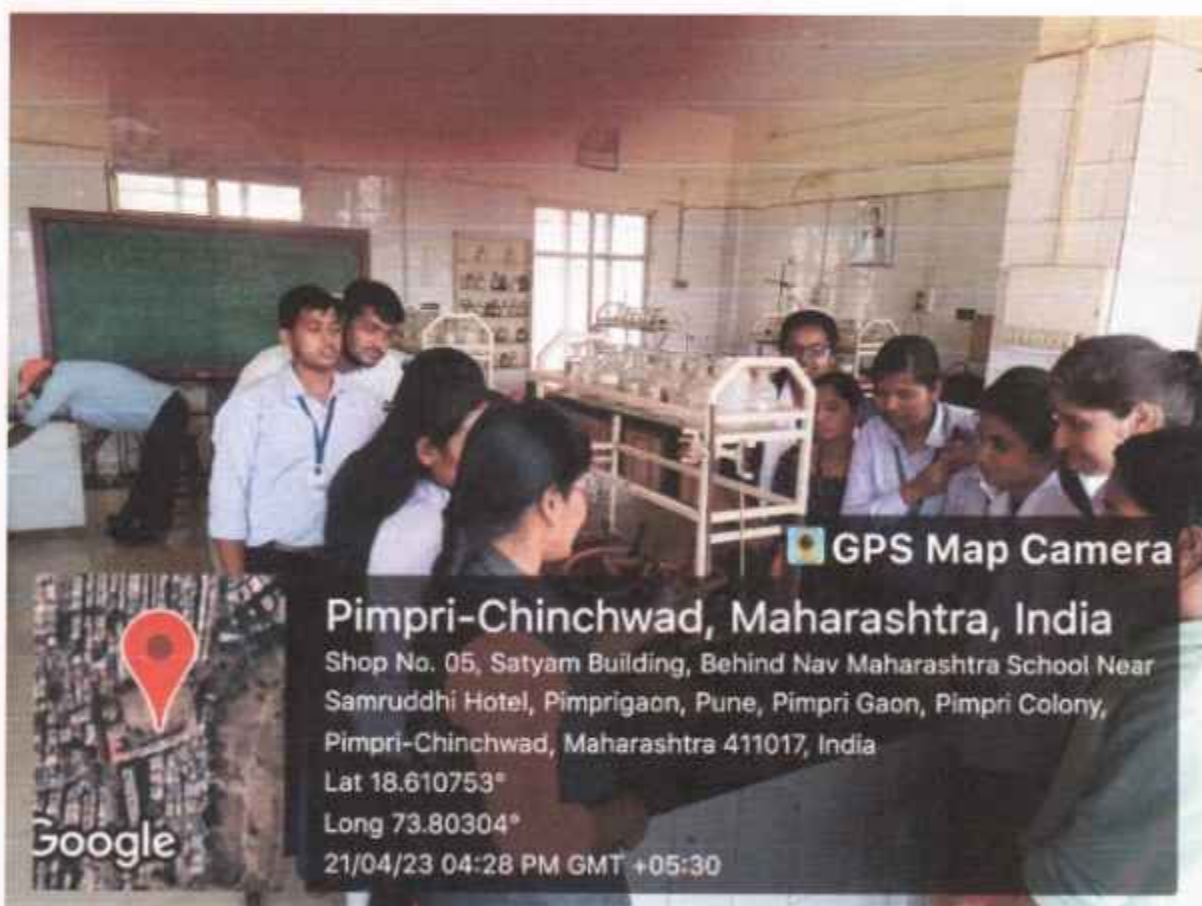
Out of syllabus Experiments were given to the students. They have to think over it and find out the required procedure for the given Experiment.

Aim: Separation and Identification of metal ions by Paper Chromatography



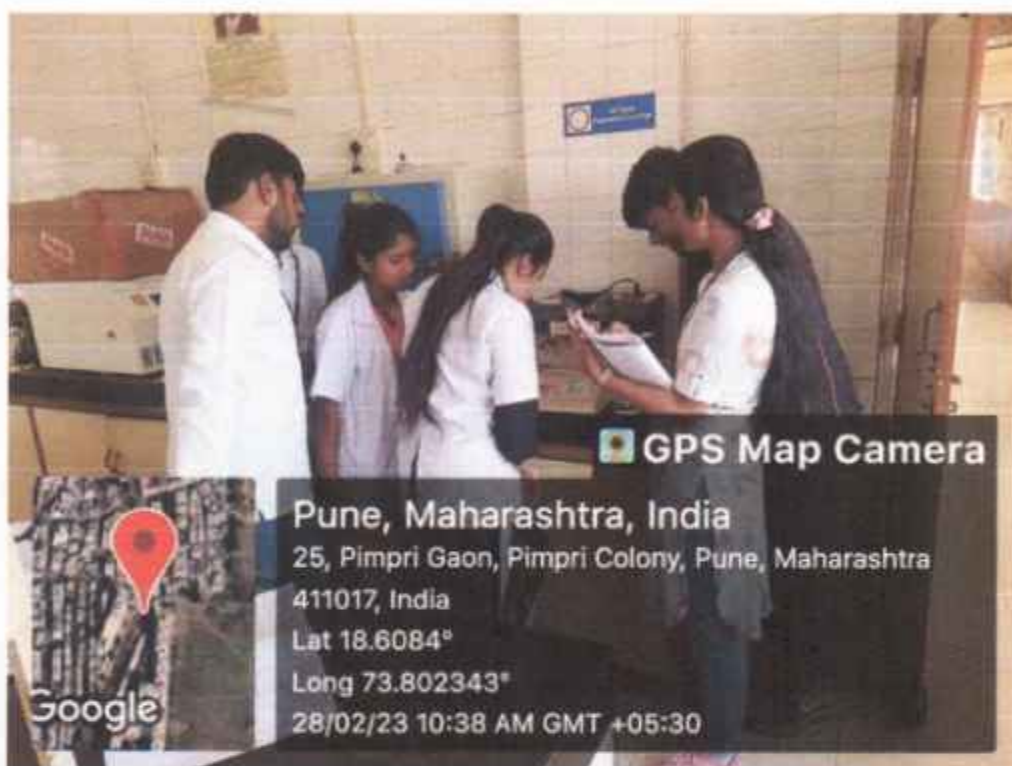
The object of the experiment was to enhance their knowledge in paper chromatography as they were familiar with separation of Amino acids.

The discussion was divided into two parts - the pros and cons of Digital Rupee


Pros:

Cons:


- **Technological Challenges:** Participants discussed the challenges of digital infrastructure and the need for significant investment to ensure the smooth functioning of Digital Rupee.

- They also argued that the growth of the digital economy has come at the cost of traditional jobs and has led to job losses in various sectors.


The debate was conducted in a highly structured and organized manner and was followed by a Question & Answer session where the students were able to clarify their arguments and respond to questions from their peers.
