23rd October 2023



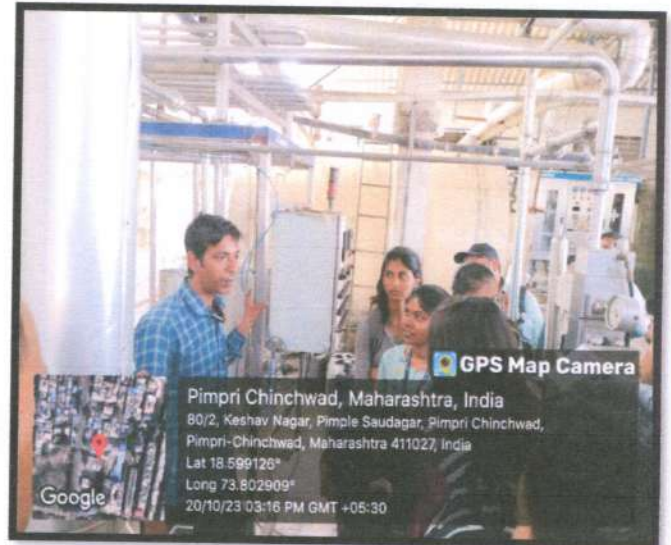

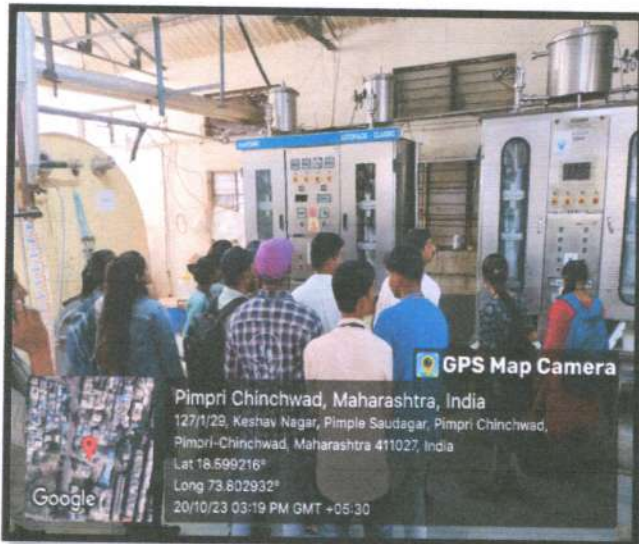

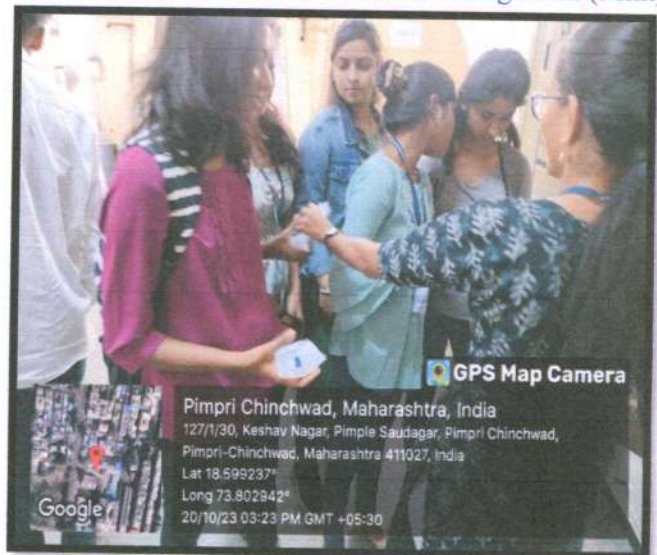
