1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? आपल्या क्लासमध्ये अभ्यासक्रम किती पूर्ण केला जातो?

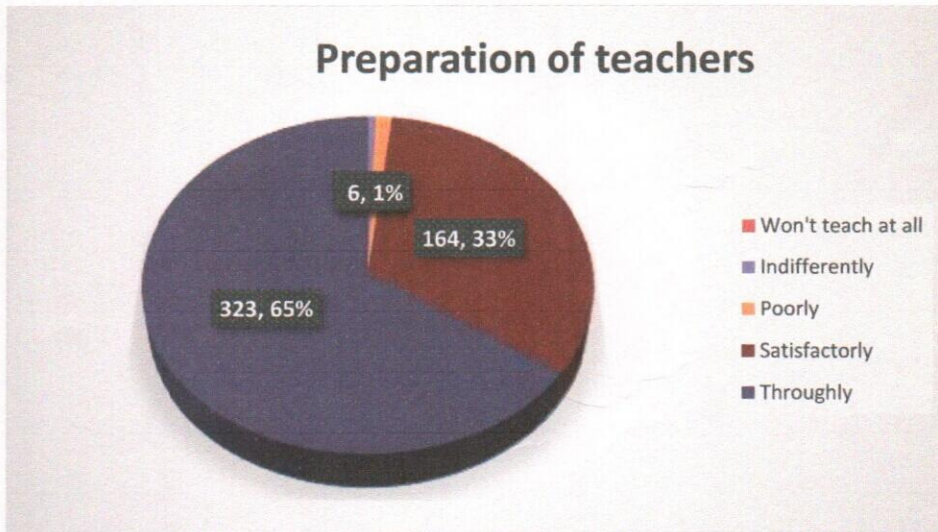

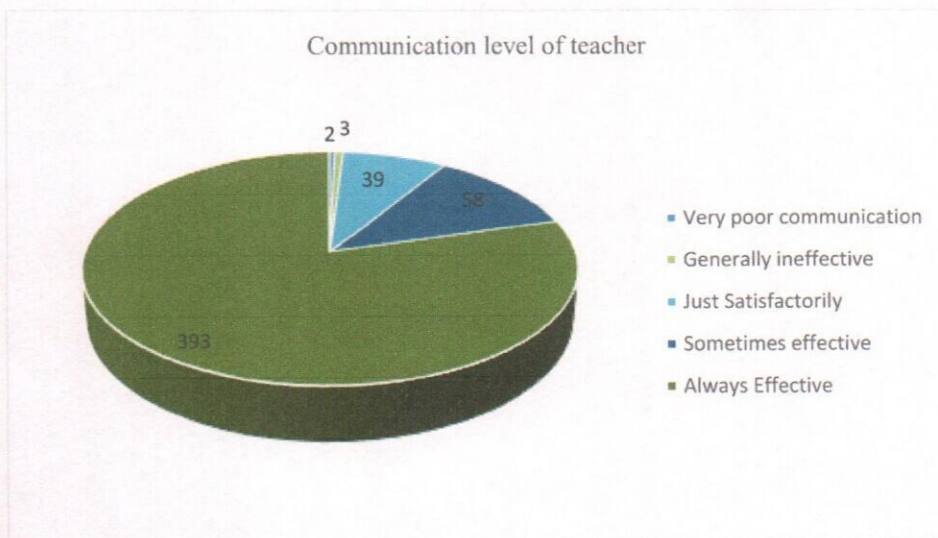

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate? शिक्षक कशाप्रकारे संवाद साधतात?

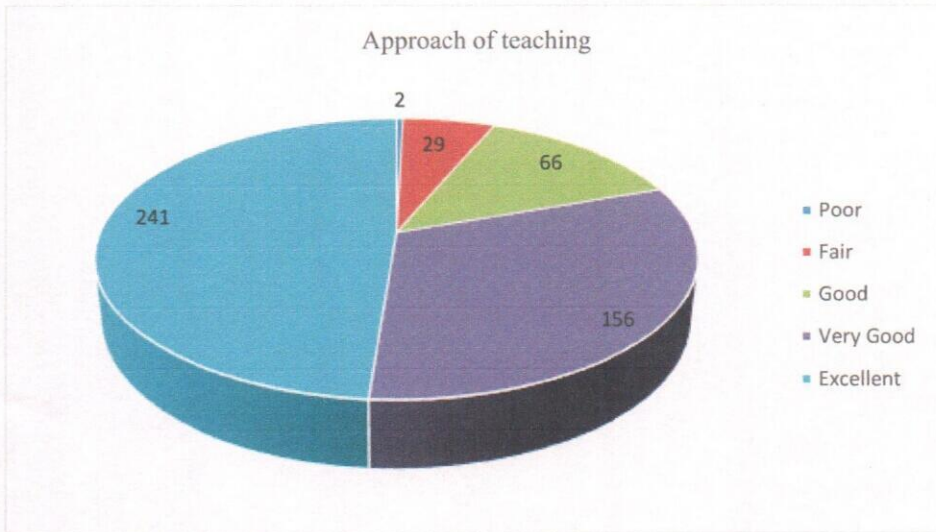

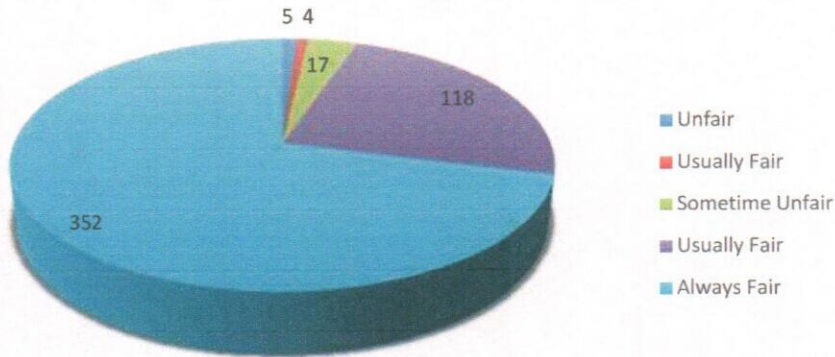

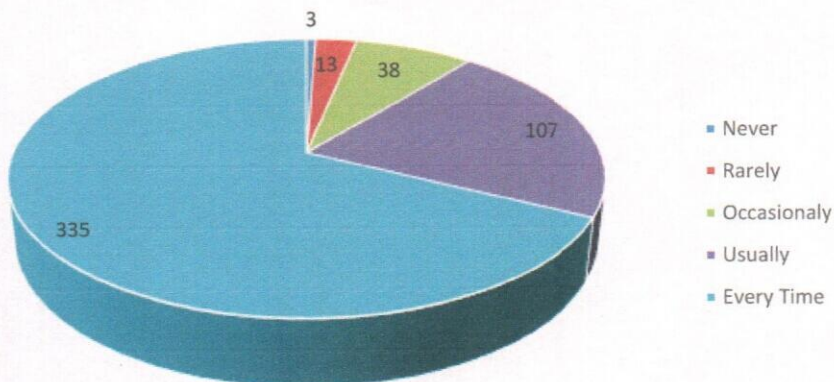

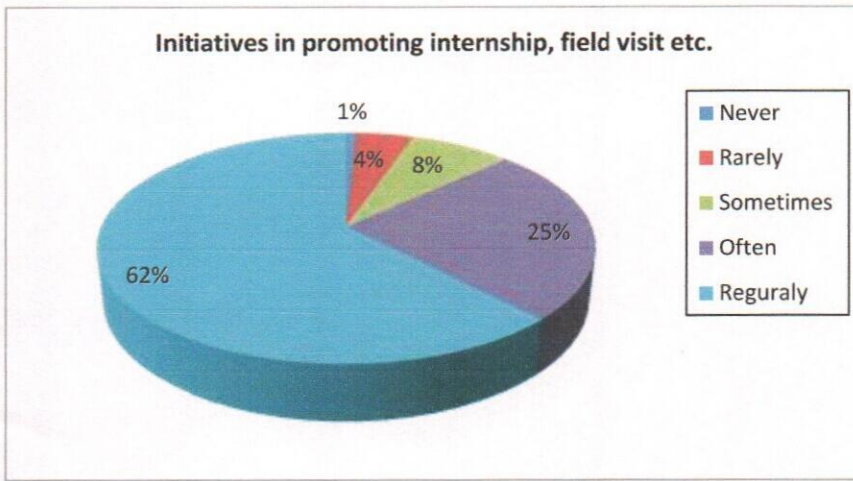

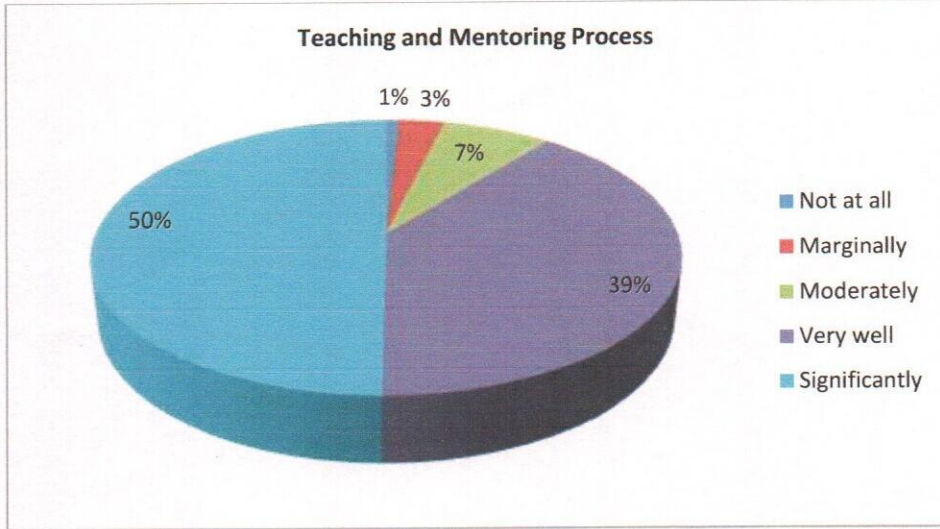

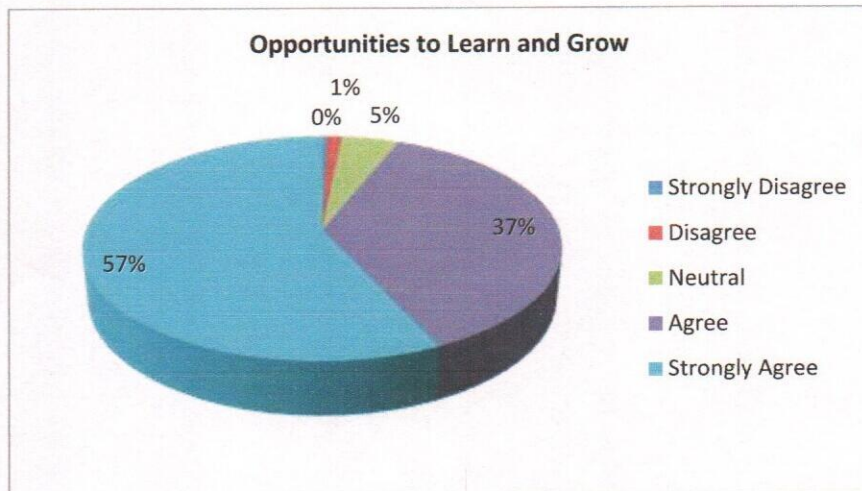

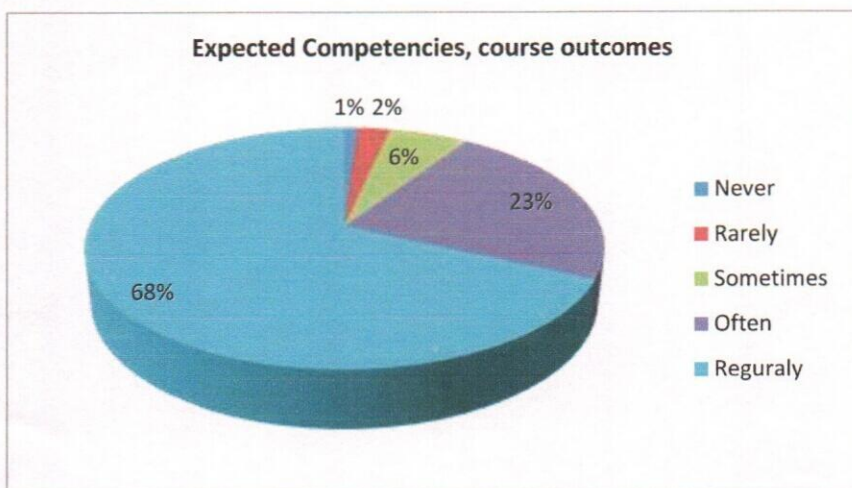

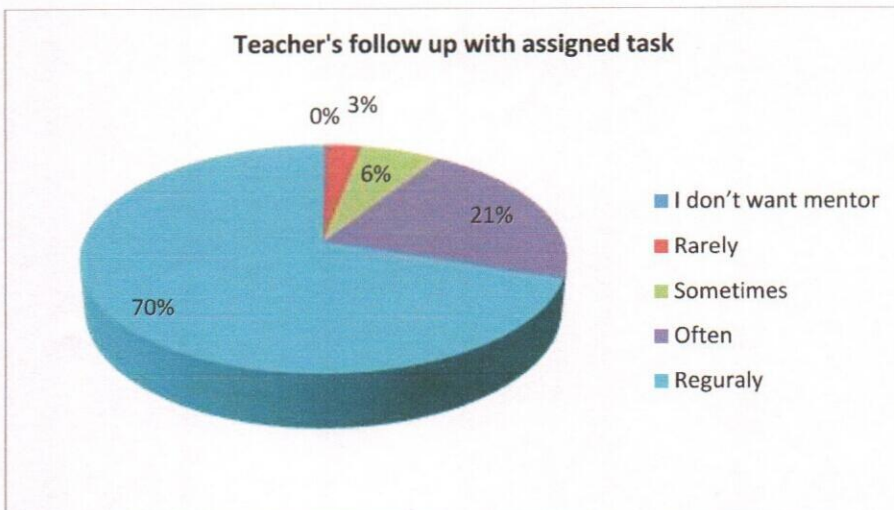

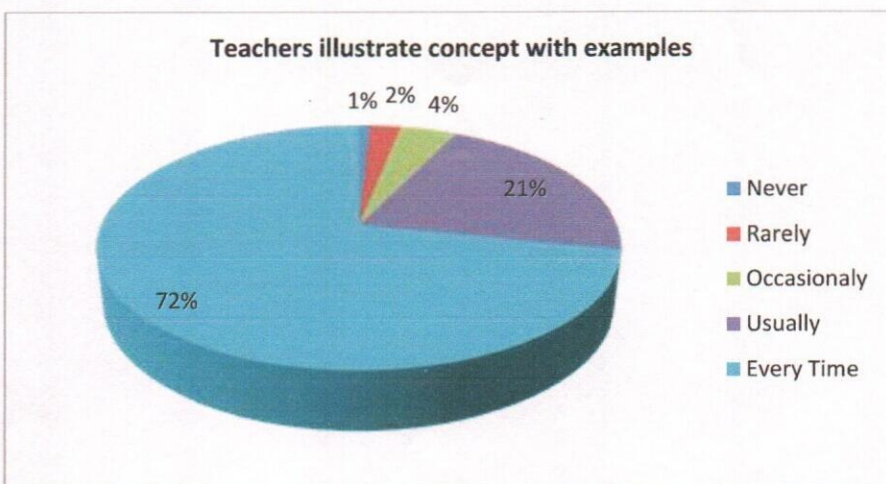

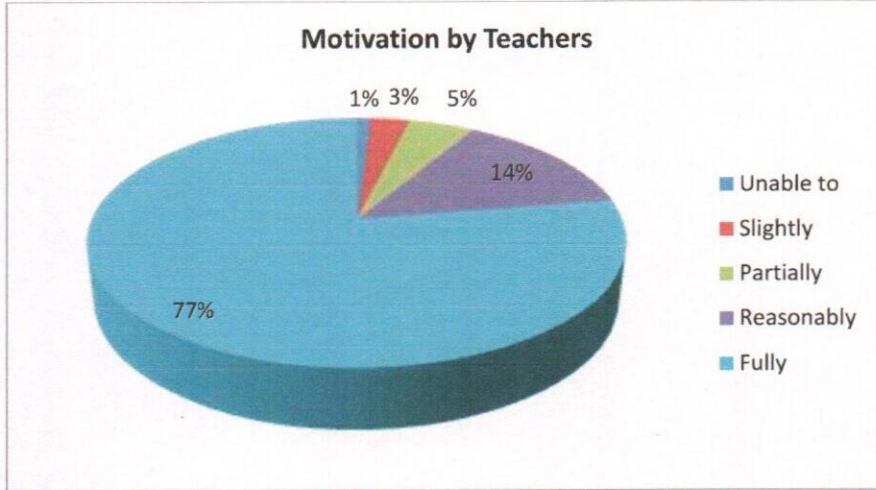

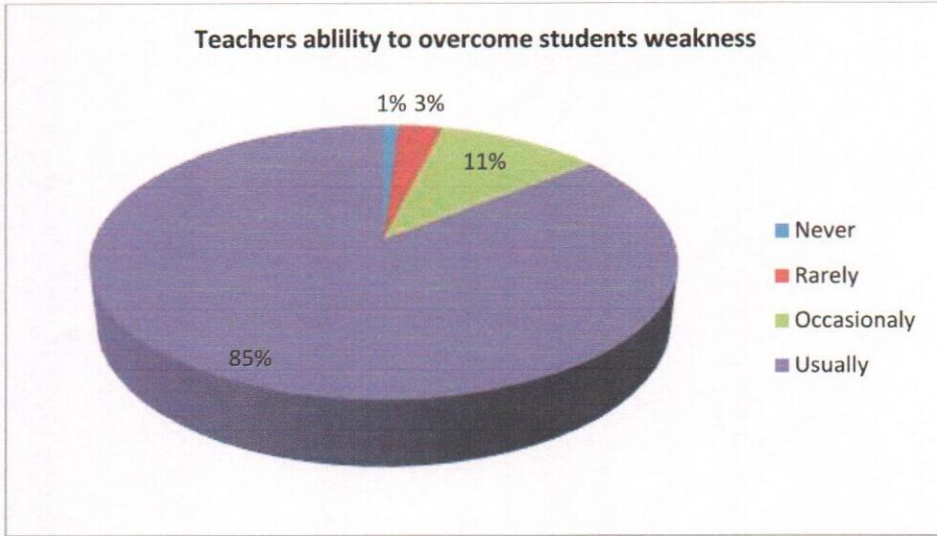

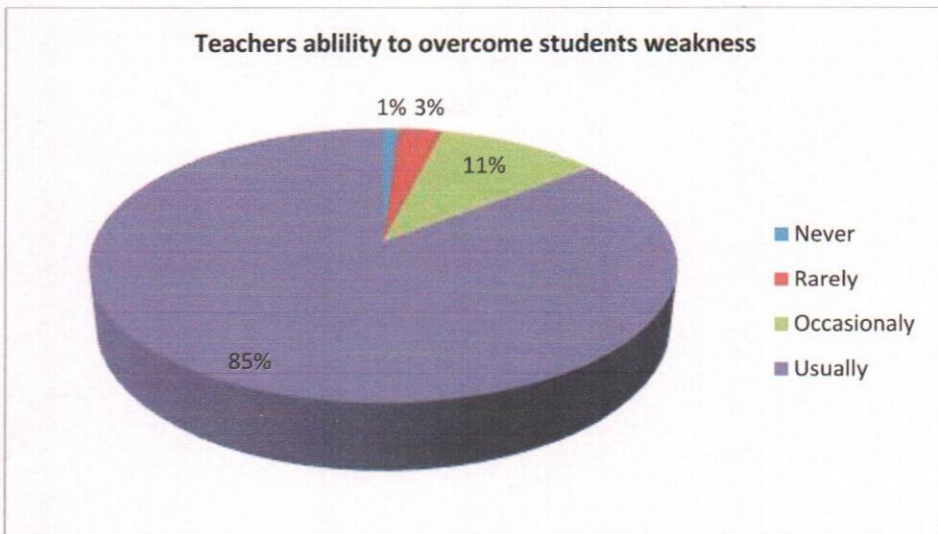

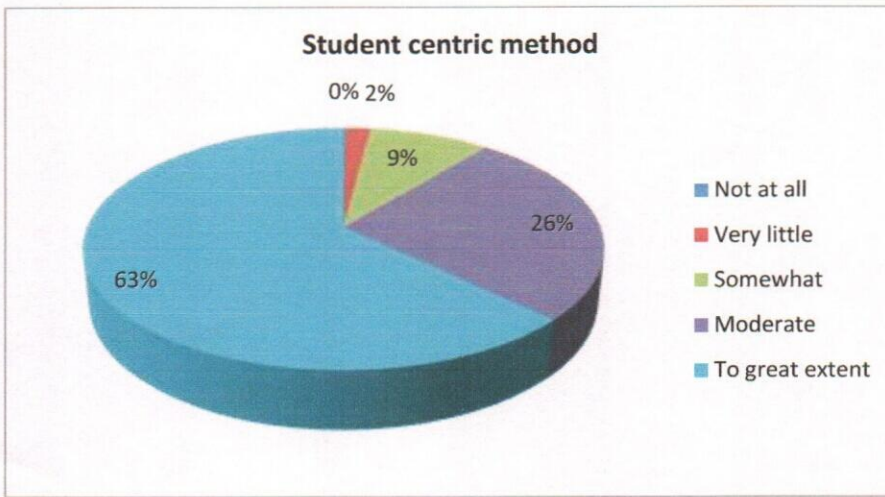

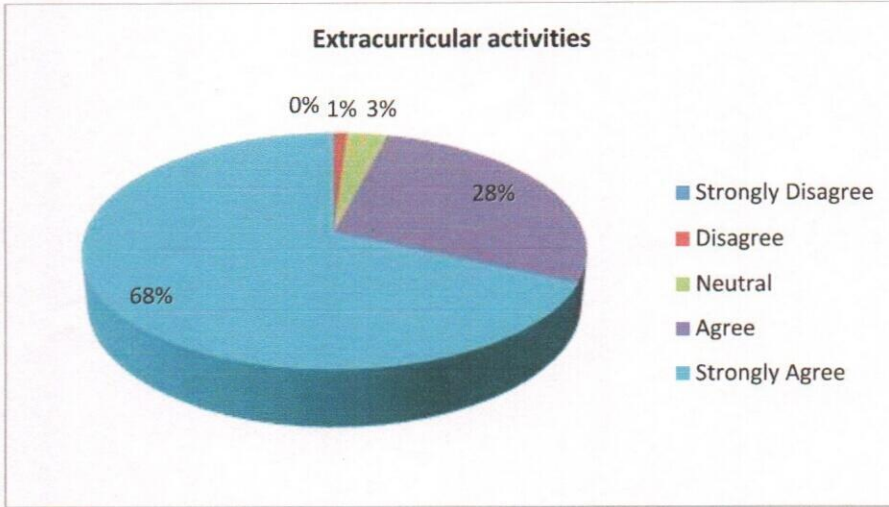

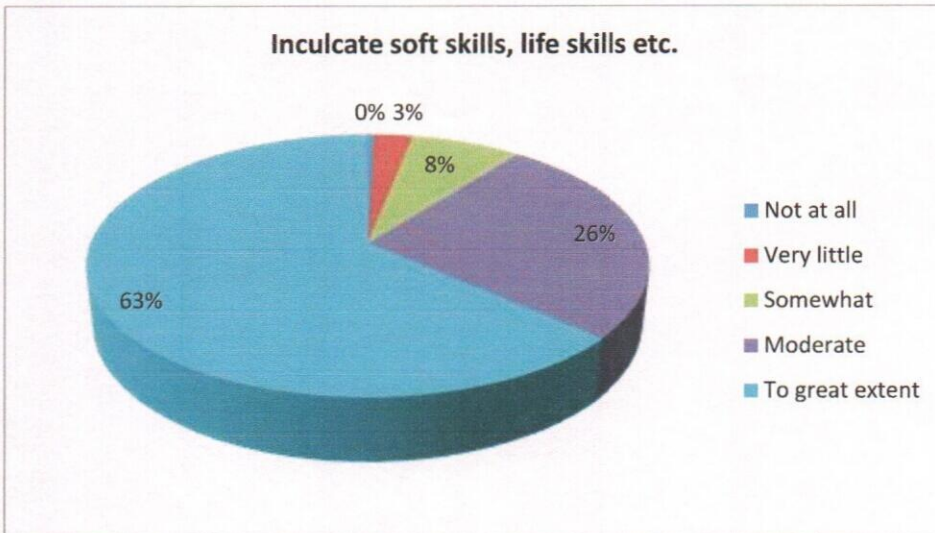

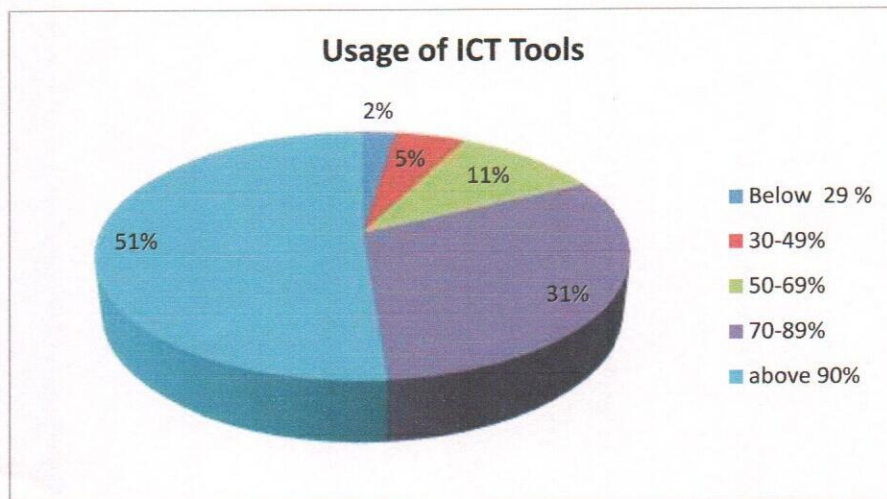

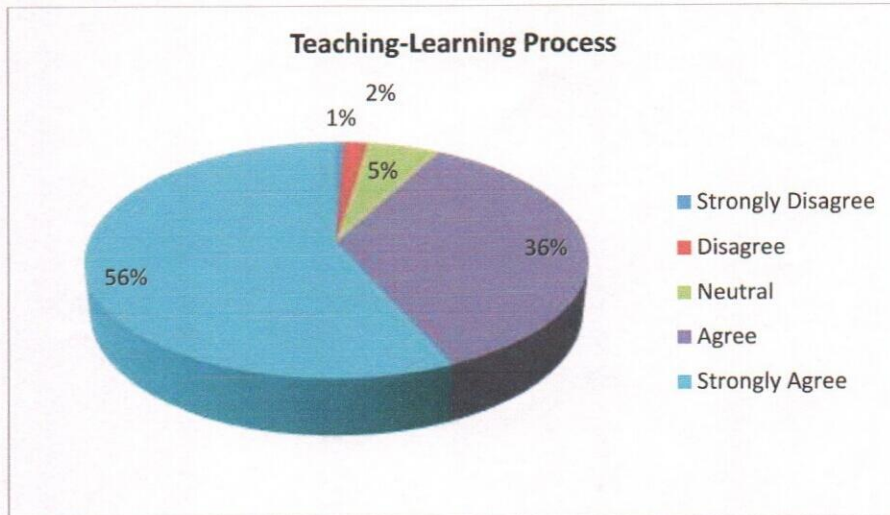
