## **WORKSHOP REPORT (PROCEEDINGS)**

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The IQAC workshop, conducted on the Thursday, November 17, 2022 commenced with enlightening of lamps with auspicious hands of the guests: the Resource Person Prof. (Dr.) R. T. Bedre, Director, UGC HRDC, Dr. Harisungh Gour Vishwavidyalaya (A Central University), Sagar, M. P. (India), the President Prin. Dr. N. S. Gaikwad, the Host Hon. Prin. Dr. Kailas Jagdale, the Vice-Principal Prof. (Dr.) Madhav Sarode, the Faculty In-charges Mr. Shahaji More and Dr. Mrunalini Shekhar of Science and Arts respectively, the Convener and Coordinator of the IQAC Dr. Neelkanth Dahale and the Co-convener and Chairperson of the NEP 2020 Cell.


At the outset, Dr. Neelkanth Dahale made introduction on the concept of the workshop. He expressed that the workshop deals with the new topic concerning the dire need of the time in Indian higher education system: creating equitable and just society on the one hand and education system with indigenous fervour on the other. He added the principle of *Ahankara* of Adya Shankaracharya into his introduction.


Prof. (Dr.) R. T. Bedre spoke on the NEP 2020 first and then turned towards its relevance and indispensability in the assessment process of the agencies like NAAC. It is the 'Institutional Preparedness of NEP 2020' as it has been coined by the NAAC itself. He surveyed on the educational commissions after independence. His was the tone that ever since the Dr. Radhakrishnan Commission the indigenous fervour has been present in all the Commissions. Also Kothari Commission covered the overall development of pupils. The objectives of these Commissions were achieved fully could linger behind. Further, he explained, followed by the discussion all the six points in the NAAC questionnaire. The Session ended with the doubts cleared by the speaker himself. Prin. Dr. N. S. Gaikwad, while presiding over the session explained further the minute details in the NAAC questionnaire.



His was the critical approach as far as the implementation level of the Policy is concerned. He wanted all the concerned to the NEP 2020 policy to be properly introduced to the policy draft by the Union Government itself. He stressed the aspect of employability needed to be attended carefully and quickly. Lest, the collective unconsciousness of the younger generation may ascend at any point of time against the credibility of the governing bodies irrespective of the sector or cadre. Prin. Dr. Kailas Jagdale presided over the session.

Valedictory Session was exclusively dedicated to the detailing on the topic of the workshop. It was supplanted by the referencing to the NHEQF points as well. This session was presided over Prin. Dr. Arun Andhale of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Mahavidyalaya, Aundh, Pune. The president underlined the importance of the skill-based education that can be acquired by the introduction of the short term courses along with the regular programme structure of the university.
